



MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT
BETWEEN
TASHKENT STATE PEDAGOGICAL UNIVERSITY
NAMED AFTER NIZAMI
AND
GYEONGNAM NATIONAL UNIVERSITY
OF SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY

The agreement in this international exchange should contribute to the academic and educational development of the two universities, based on friendship and mutual benefit between the **Tashkent State Pedagogical University named after Nizami, Tashkent, Uzbekistan** and the **Gyeongnam National University of Science and Technology (GNTECH) of Korea**.

Article 1. Type and method of exchange

- A. Exchange of students, faculties and research between the universities
- B. During student exchange of education and research exchange, credit exchange is conducted for long-term programs.

Article 2. Exchange of Students

- A. Long Term Program
 - i. The accepting applicant is to prepare the content, organization, and conditions necessary to implement the planned educational program based on an agreement between both universities.
 - ii. The party to send students to the partner university shall submit necessary documents (application form, resume, guardian agreement, academic certificate, student certificate, etc.) as soon as possible

- iii. The number of students shall be limited to no more than two (2) students per university.
- iv. The period of student exchange shall be limited to no longer than one year in principle.
- v. Credits based on transcript, which earned by exchange students during their stay at the partner university, are to transfer back to their original university and to be fully accredited.
- vi. The following principles shall be applied to foreign students regarding tuition and expenses.
 - a) The students shall be responsible for all expenses including round-trip transportation, studying materials, and living expenses (excluding accommodation fee) overseas.
 - b) Those who accept foreign students shall waive tuition fees and other school-related fees (admission fee, commission of admission, and tuition fee).
 - c) Those who accept international students should provide free accommodation. However, students themselves are responsible for food and living expenses (utility bills and others).
 - d) Various insurance and medical expenses shall be paid by the students themselves.

B. Short-Term Program

- i. If there is a request from either party, make sure that the request is accepted as long as the school receiving the students studying abroad has no problem.
- ii. Make a separate agreement on the number of students allowed to participate in the study abroad program, the length of the study abroad program, and expenses.

Article3. Exchange of Professors

- A. The two universities implement teacher exchanges without interruption to both schools.

B. Short-Term Exchange

- i. The period of exchange shall be within two (2) weeks in principle.

ii. Following principles are regarding the expenses of Short-Term Exchange of Professors.

- a) University receiving exchange professors shall provide a small number of lectures for exchange professors.
- b) Parties sending the exchange professors shall cover expenses pertaining to round-trip transportation and living (exclude accommodation).
- c) Parties accepting the exchange professors shall cover expenses pertaining to accommodation.
- d) The income for the exchange professor who provides lectures will be paid for by the partner university according to the regulations of the accepting university.


C. Long-Term Exchange

- i. The period of exchange shall be within six (6) months and one (1) year in principle.
- ii. The period, procedures and expenses of the dispatch to perform the Long-Term Exchange of Professors will be conducted with mutual consent by both institutes.


This agreement will be valid for five (5) years from the date of signing, and the duration may automatically be extended by a mutual consent of both institutes unless both institutions agree to terminate the agreement upon such terms as are mutually agreeable to the institutors. However, this agreement may be terminated by the action of both institutions only with sufficient reasons and with prior notice in principle. Also, This agreement shall be executed in two copies in English and both universities will retain one copy each.
